**Subject: ENROLLED NURSES AND NURSING ASSISTANTS (GOVERNMENT) AWARD - ALLOWANCES**

---

On July 8, 1991, the Western Australian Industrial Relations Commission amended the above award in respect of the allowances prescribed under Clauses 8 Overtime, 17 Transfer and 19 Laundry Allowance. A copy of the amending order is attached.

The effect of the amendment is to ensure that the allowances provisions are adjusted to take account of national wage increases occurring over the period since adjustments were last made in 1986.

The order is effective from the beginning of the first pay period commencing on or after July 8, 1991.

The variations in rates is to be costed and advice forwarded to your Director, Health Region/Services\* on either form D1 Monthly Summary of Salary and Wage increases or a similar form, to accompany your Management Report for the month of August. If no costs are incurred as a result of the variation a 'Nil' return must be forwarded.

\* Services includes State Health Laboratory Services, Dental Health Services, Graylands, Central Metropolitan Services etc.

O R D E R

HAVING heard Ms R. Roberts on behalf of the Applicant and Ms M.H. Kuhne on behalf of the Respondents, and by consent, the Commission, pursuant to the powers conferred on it under the Industrial Relations Act, 1979 hereby orders -

THAT the Enrolled Nurses and Nursing Assistants (Government) Award be varied in accordance with the following Schedule and that such variation shall have effect from the beginning of the first pay period commencing on or after the 8th day of July, 1991.

SCHEDULE

1. Clause 8. - Overtime: Delete the rate of \$4.05 in subclause (5) and insert \$5.40 in lieu thereof.
2. Clause 17. - Transfer: Delete the rates of \$4.05 and \$1.50 in subclause (2) and insert the rates \$5.40 and \$2.20 in lieu thereof.
3. Clause 19. - Laundry Allowance: Delete the rate of 65 cents in subclause (7) and insert \$1.00 in lieu thereof.
