Subject: ANNUAL LEAVE LOADING 2001 MAXIMUM LOADING ALLOWED FOR WAGES EMPLOYEES AND SALARIED OFFICERS
COST VARIATION NO: 26-001-09

With regards to maximum leave loading amounts that may be paid on annual leave, the Department of Productivity and Labour Relations (DOPLAR) in circular to Departments and Authorities No 9 of 2000, has advised the following:

WAGES EMPLOYEES

The maximum annual leave loading that may be paid on four weeks' annual leave commencing from 1 October 2000 is **\$778.40**.

The maximum amount for shift workers entitled to one weeks' additional annual leave within their award is **\$973.00** for leave commencing from 1 October 2000.

SALARIED OFFICERS

The maximum loading prescribed above also applies to salaried officers commencing annual leave after **31 December 2000**.

The variation is to be costed and advice forwarded to your Health Service General Manager or Director as appropriate, to accompany your management report. If no costs are incurred, a nil variation must be forwarded.

Provisions of an award, workplace or registered enterprise agreement that are contrary to this circular will override the circular. For example, if an agreement provides for a cap higher than that contained in this circular then the amount in the agreement prevails.
