



Outpatient Quarterly Activity Western Australian Metropolitan Hospitals March 2011 Quarter

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Key Points

March 2008 quarter to March 2011 quarter

All appointments

Quarterly all (ie new and follow up) appointments grew by 15,546, from 136,311 to 151,857 at all metropolitan teaching hospitals, an increase of 11.4%.

New appointments

Quarterly new appointments grew by 4,015, from 30,661 to 34,676 at all metropolitan teaching hospitals, an increase of 13.1%.

First appointments

At all metropolitan teaching hospitals:

- quarterly first appointments grew by 4,365, from 27,566 to 31,931, an increase of 15.8%
- median waiting times increased from 1.05 to 1.08 months.

Total appointments

Quarterly total (ie new, follow up and DNA) appointments grew by 19,310, from 158,596 to 177,906 at all metropolitan teaching hospitals, an increase of 12.2%.

Did not attend appointments

At all metropolitan teaching hospitals:

- quarterly did not attend (DNA) appointments grew by 3,764, from 22,285 to 26,049
- the proportion of DNA appointments of total appointments increased from 14.1% to 14.6%.

Glossary

Mean: This refers to the arithmetic mean, being the sum of all values in the list divided by the number of items in the list. The mean is the most commonly used type of average and can also be referred to simply as the average.

Median: This refers to the value separating the higher half of a sample, a population, or a probability distribution, from the lower half. This statistic is used, in preference to the mean, when the distribution of the values is skewed by a small number of very high values.

90th percentile: This refers to the value in the list below which there are 90 percent of numbers and enables waiting times to be expressed as a percentile rank.

However, as percentile ranks are not on equal interval scales, the difference between any two scores is not the same as between any other two scores.

For instance, the difference (25) between 90 and 65 is not the same as the difference (25) between 50 and 25 because position rank of a percentile is based on an assumed normal distribution of all values.

Introduction

The purpose of this report is to provide summary quarterly data about attendances at outpatient clinics operating at metropolitan teaching hospitals, including Royal Perth Hospital (RPH), RPH Shenton Park Campus (RPHSPC), Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital (SCGH), Fremantle Hospital (FH), King Edward Memorial Hospital (KEMH) and Princess Margaret Hospital (PMH).

In addition to activity at metropolitan teaching hospitals, which accounts for the greatest proportion of outpatient clinics, information is also presented for outpatient clinics undertaken at metropolitan non teaching hospitals based on matched and non matched specialties.

1. Appointments

1.1 All appointments

Up to present quarter

Table 1 indicates that all (ie, new and follow up) appointments grew by 19,770, from the March 2007 quarter (132,087) to the current quarter (151,857), an increase of 15.0%.

Over last three years

Table 1 shows that compared with the same quarter three years ago, all appointments grew by 15,546, from the March 2008 quarter (136,311) to

the March 2011 quarter (151,857), an increase of 11.4%.

Trends by hospital

Trends in new and follow up appointments for each metropolitan teaching hospital are contained in Tables A-1 to A-3 (pages A-1 to A-3).

1.2 First appointments

Due to differences in definition, as noted in the Notes (page A-52), separate counts of new and first appointments are provided in Table 1.

First appointments refer to patients who have not previously attended an outpatient clinic, whereas new appointments may include multiple counts for a patient related to attendance at an outpatient clinic.


Up to present quarter

Table 1 (page 2) indicates that first appointments grew by 5,913, from the March 2007 quarter (26,018) to the current quarter (31,931), an increase of 22.7%. See also Figure 1.

Over last three years

Table 1 (page 2) shows that, compared with the same quarter three years ago, first appointments grew by 4,365 from the March 2008 quarter (27,566) to the March 2011 quarter (31,931), an increase of 15.8%.

Trends by hospital

Trends in first appointments for each metropolitan teaching hospital are contained in Tables A-4 to A-6 (pages A-4 to A-6).

1.3 New appointments

Up to present quarter

Table 1 (page 2) indicates that new appointments grew by 7,628, from the March 2007 quarter (27,048) to the current quarter (34,676), an increase of 28.2%.

It can also be seen the proportion of new appointments increased from the March 2007 quarter (20.5%) to the current quarter (22.8%). See also Figure 2 (page 4).

Over last three years

Table 1 (page 2) shows that compared with the same quarter three years ago, new appointments grew by 4,015, from the March quarter 2008 (30,661) to the current quarter (34,676), an increase of 13.1%.

Trends by hospital

Trends in new appointments for each metropolitan teaching hospital are contained in Tables A-1 to A-3 (pages A-1 to A-3). This data indicates that, overall, in the past two years, lower proportions of new appointments were reported by RPH and SCGH compared to the other metropolitan teaching hospitals.

1.4 Did not attend

Up to present quarter

Table 2 indicates that did not attend (DNA) appointments grew by 2,872, from the March 2007 quarter (23,177) to the current quarter (26,049), an increase of 12.4%.

Figure 3 (page 4) presents trends in the proportion of DNA appointments and total (ie new, follow up and DNA) appointments. This figure shows that, overall, the proportion of DNA appointments have remained relatively stable from the March 2007 quarter to the current quarter.

Over last three years

Table 2 also shows that compared with the same quarter three years ago, DNA appointments grew by 3,764, from the March quarter 2008 (22,285)

to the current quarter (26,049), an increase of 16.9%.

Trends by hospital

Trends in DNA appointments for each metropolitan teaching hospital are contained in Tables A-7 to A-9 (pages A-7 to A-9).

This data indicates that, overall, higher proportions of DNA appointments were reported by RPH, KEMH and PMH compared to the other metropolitan teaching hospitals.

1.5 Total appointments

Up to present quarter

Table 2 indicates that total (ie new, follow up and DNA) appointments grew by 22,642, from the March 2007 quarter (155,264) to the current quarter (177,906), an increase of 14.6%.

Over last three years





Figure 3: Total appointments & proportion (%) of DNA outpatient appointments at all metropolitan teaching hospitals, March 2007 quarter- March 2011 quarter

Table 2 also shows that compared with the same quarter three years ago, total appointments grew by 19,310, from the March 2008 quarter (158,596) to the current quarter (177,906), an increase of 12.2%. See also Figure 3 (page 4).

Trends by hospital

Trends in total appointments for each metropolitan teaching hospital are contained in Tables A-7 to A-9 (pages A-7 to A-9).

2. Waiting Times

Up to present quarter

Median waiting time in months to first appointment at all metropolitan teaching hospitals is presented in Table 1 (page 2).

Table 1 shows that, overall, median waiting time declined from the March 2007 quarter (1.18 months) to the current quarter (1.08 months).

Over last three years

Table 1 (page 2) shows that compared with the same quarter three years ago, median waiting time increased from 1.05 to 1.08 months. See also Figure 1 (page 1).

Trends by hospital

Trends in mean, median and 90th percentile waiting time (months) and counts of first appointments for each metropolitan teaching hospital are contained in Tables A-4 to A-6 (pages A-4 to A-6).

Figure 2: Attendances by type of outpatient appointment at all metropolitan teaching hospitals, March 2007 quarter - March 2011 quarter

It should be noted that variations between hospitals in waiting times are related to demographic, casemix and other factors.

3. Specialty

A quarterly detailed breakdown of new appointments by specialty for all metropolitan teaching hospitals, as well as for each hospital, is contained in Tables A-10 to A-30 (pages A-10 to A-51).

4. Metro Hospitals

The inclusion of data for outpatient clinics at non teaching hospitals involves matching the descriptions of appointments according to specialty at both teaching and non teaching metropolitan hospitals.

Separation of matched from non matched outpatient appointments at non teaching hospitals is required to ensure inclusion of comparable data from non teaching hospitals within teaching hospital totals.

Table 3 provides a summary of quarterly outpatient appointments at metropolitan non teaching hospitals, broken down by matched and non matched specialties.

Table 4 (page 6) provides a summary of quarterly outpatient appointments based on matched specialties at metropolitan teaching and non teaching hospitals.

Teaching & non teaching hospitals

Total matched new appointments at metropolitan teaching and non teaching hospitals grew by 9,712, from the March quarter 2007 (30,426) to the current quarter (40,138), an increase of 31.9%. See Table 4 (page 6).

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Total matched all appointments at metropolitan teaching and non teaching hospitals grew by 22,335 from the March quarter 2007 (138,300) to the current quarter (160,635), an increase of 16.1%. See Table 4 (page 6).

Non teaching hospitals

Matched new appointments at metropolitan non teaching hospitals grew by 2,084, from the March quarter 2007 (3,378) to the current quarter (5,462), an increase of 61.7%. See Table 4.

Matched all appointments at metropolitan non teaching hospitals grew by 2,565, from the March quarter 2007 (6,213) to the current quarter (8,778), an increase of 41.3%. See Table 4.

Notes

Data extraction date

All data in this report is based on appointments to the end of the last day in each month or quarter extracted from the TOPAS data system, a subset of all outpatient appointments.

Data revision

Minor variations for totals published in previous reports are likely to occur as the outpatient databases are continuously updated. Variations may occur for a number of reasons, such as updates to procedure codes, lags in data processing or other types of errors detected after publication.

There is ongoing revision of the data from January 2009 to the current month. Therefore, the most recent edition of a report should always be consulted, as data is not revised in previously published editions.

Data exclusion

Counts are based on comparable specialties for both teaching and non teaching hospitals. This means, for example, that some types of appointments, such as physiotherapy are not counted. As the data in this report refers to only medical and surgical outpatient activity, it does not include data related to allied health and diagnostic outpatient services.

Effects of rounding

Where figures have been rounded, discrepancies may occur between sums of the component items and totals. Published percentages are calculated prior to rounding of the figures and therefore some discrepancy may exist between these percentages and those that could be calculated from the rounded figures.

Metropolitan public hospitals

The term 'metropolitan public hospital' refers to the public hospitals which are located in the North Metropolitan and South Metropolitan Area Health Services.

Booked appointments

Due to inconsistencies in the data system that reports and tracks booked appointments for outpatient services, separate data is provided with respect to both first and new appointments.

First appointment

A first appointment refers to an appointment where a patient has never before attended a clinic of that specialty at that hospital.

New appointment

New appointments can have multiple entries, as the appointment recording system allocates a maximum of 45 minutes per appointment. If a further extended appointment is required, this attendance is also recorded as a 'new' appointment until a follow up session is required.

Follow up appointment

A follow up appointment refers to a subsequent appointment and is typically shorter than a new appointment, eg 15 to 20 mins in duration.

Specialty

The list of outpatient specialties refers to clinically related provision of services as defined by each hospital.

Definition of appointment

Attendance at an outpatient appointment is based on counts of medical and surgical appointments, as defined in field SB19 in the Outpatient Database.

Teaching hospital

Encompasses the five adult metropolitan teaching hospitals (ie Royal Perth Hospital, Royal Perth Hospital Shenton Campus, Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital, Fremantle Hospital and King Edward Memorial Hospital) and the metropolitan children's hospital (ie Princess Margaret Hospital).
