Gain a graduate program to start your career in WA Health

A graduate (or transition to practice) program can give you the start you need for a career in nursing and midwifery in a variety of settings. Completion of a graduate program will assist you to gaining the experience to further your career progression. GradConnect is an online recruitment system that can link you to numerous graduate programs in WA.

Why GradConnect

GradConnect has been tailored for Aboriginal undergraduates with cultural safety embedded across the recruitment process.

Entrance requirements

You will need to have completed your nursing or midwifery studies in Australia within **the last 12 months at the time of application** (i.e., no more than 12 months since graduation).

You must **not have worked more than 3 months full-time equivalent (494 hours)** at the time of application, in the designation you are applying for (e.g., a registered nurse applicant who worked over 494 hours as an enrolled nurse will still be eligible to apply to a registered nurse graduate program.)
