

# Designated Registered Nurse Prescribing National Implementation Oversight Group

## Meeting #6 Communique – 02 June 2026

The Implementation Oversight Group (IOG) met for the sixth time to guide the national roll-out of designated RN prescribing. Key items discussed at the meeting were:

- Best ways of collecting and sharing data around endorsed designated RN prescribers by jurisdiction
- Update on the work of the Pharmaceutical Benefits Advisory Committee who are considering what medicines are suitable for prescribing by designated RN prescribers
- Update on the national legislation amendments and the Services Australia changes required to support designated RN prescribing medication subsidised by the PBS
- Updates to the program risk and issue register.
