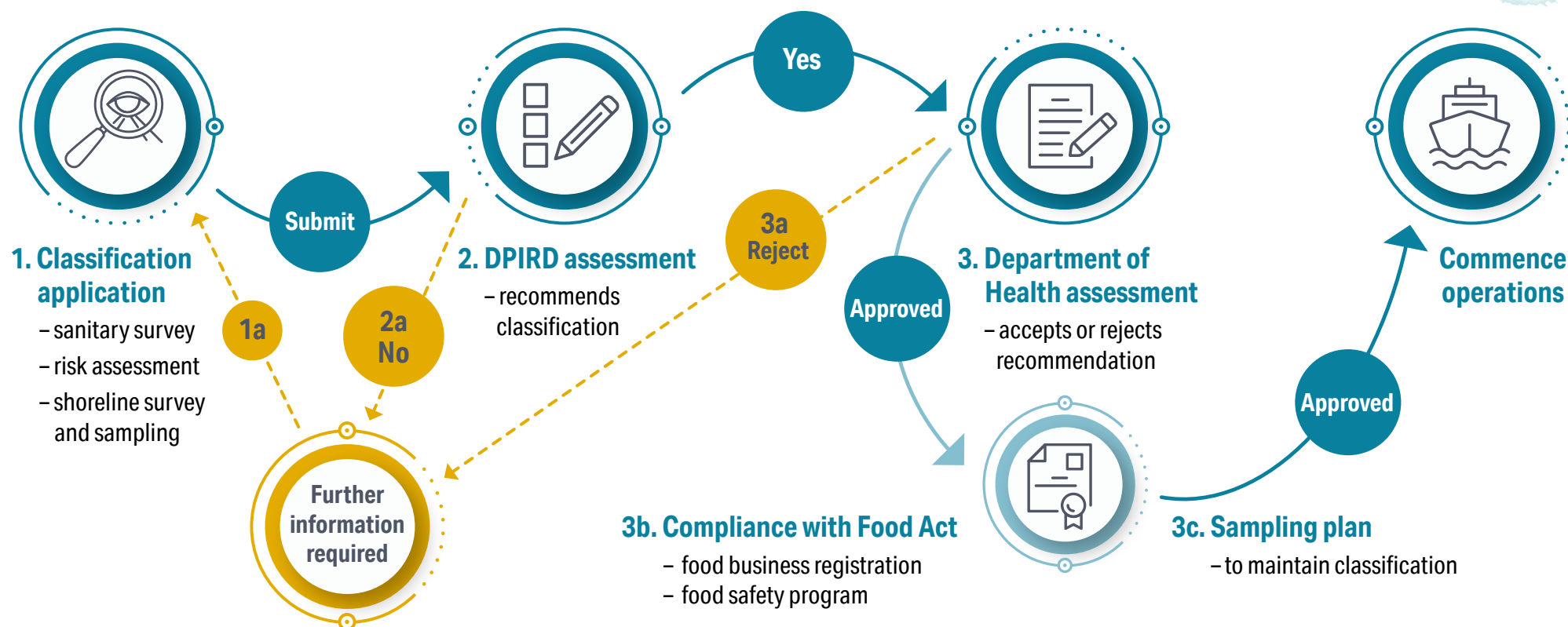




Classification process for new bivalve mollusc businesses
