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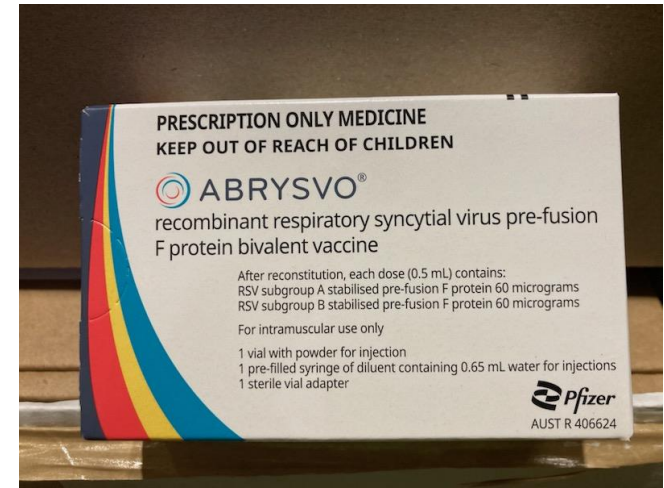
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Immunisation management

Abrysvo availability

- Abrysvo will be available for ordering via Onelink from 23 January
- Ordering limits apply
- Sufficient supply in pipeline
- Not to be used before 3 February
- NIP funding applies to maternal cohort only.
- (≥ 60 years required to access privately)
- Place your Abrysvo orders with your other routine orders

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Immunisation management

Beyfortus availability

- Will be available to order in March
- Prioritise use of Beyfortus currently in fridges **prior to ordering new stock.**
 - Beyfortus ordered for the 2024 Program expires on 31 May 2025
- Great effort to recall unused doses in 2024
- Order of initial and limits will apply

Stop the TagAlert

Pressing and hold the Stop button for 5 seconds, until the stop sign icon appears on the screen.

Receiving Vaccines: Reading a TagAlert Monitor

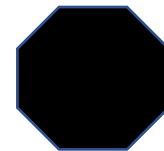
Step 1: PRESS AND HOLD STOP BUTTON!

Press & hold the STOP button  for approximately 5 seconds until an Octagon  icon appears 

Step 2: Identify whether there has been a cold chain breach.



If the arrow is pointing to the green tick, no alarms have been triggered and the delivery is **suitable for use** (Figure 1)



Cold chain

YOU MUST REPORT ALL COLD CHAIN BREACHES

- Above 8°C
- Below 2°C
- Cold chain breach is reported to your local Public Health Unit.

Cold chain

- Make sure you have enough space in your vaccine fridge
- Do not pack the fridge too full or place against the fridge wall
- Data logger in your fridge with min/max recording every 5 minutes with download function in table format.
- Do not store any product outside of original packaging to protect from light

Important reminders

- Ensure your Onelink account email is current for receiving updates and important communication
- Update your account details directly with Onelink
