AOD Clinicians/ AOD Clinical Liaison/ Dual Diagnosis Staff	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Early engagement and service provision (including screening and intervention), comprehensive AOD assessment and appropriate management of drug and alcohol related conditions during hospital presentations and/or during care. • Consultation – advice regarding the management of alcohol and other drug-related issues for referred patients. • Liaison – supporting patients with AOD presentations to access appropriate referral and care pathways by providing specialist and expert navigation through the health system, including into community-based AOD treatment services. • Education and mentorship (formal and informal) – enhancing the capacity of generalist health providers to address alcohol and other drug-related issues in their routine clinical work.
