FAQs	<p>Sustainable Health Review background</p> <p>In June 2017, the Government of Western Australia (WA) announced the Sustainable Health Review (SHR) to guide the future direction of the WA health system. The focus of the Review is on creating a more sustainable health system in WA to make sure all West Australians have access to quality health care for years to come. Since the announcement, a SHR Panel, led by an independent chair has been established to undertake the Review.</p> <p>Interim Report background and findings</p> <p>In early 2018, following a period of significant consultation with stakeholders across WA, the SHR Panel delivered its findings to Government through the SHR Interim Report. The report outlines the observations and views of the Panel based on what they have heard so far.</p> <p>The Interim Report can be found here: Sustainable Health Review Interim Report</p> <p>It focuses on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Building a case for change through understanding the current state of the health system in WA; • Clarifying the approach to sustainability and what this means for the health system in WA; and • Identifying 12 Preliminary Directions the Panel believe the WA health system should focus to create a more sustainable future. <p>The 12 Directions are underpinned by recommendations for immediate action, as well as a range of areas for further work which will inform the next phase of consultation and support the development of a Final Report and Recommendations.</p> <p>Following the release of the Interim Report, a second phase of consultation has now commenced to inform the development of the Final Report to be delivered to Government in November 2018.</p> <p>Purpose of the consultation</p> <p>As part of the second phase of consultation, the Panel would like to invite organisations and the community to provide feedback on the Interim Report and Preliminary Directions. The Panel values the views of the WA community as they bring valuable insights and ideas, as well as experiences.</p> <p>Who was the consultation commissioned by?</p> <p>The feedback survey is conducted on behalf of the Sustainable Health Review Panel.</p> <p>Who will see the feedback?</p> <p>The results will be presented to the Sustainable Health Review Panel. The Sustainable Health Review Team at Department of Health will analyse the feedback.</p>

Who can provide feedback?

The Sustainable Health Review Interim Report Public Feedback is open to all West Australians.

Please note that WA health employees are able to provide their input through a separate survey in March 2018.

Do I have to provide feedback?

Providing feedback is a voluntary. However, your feedback and input into the future of the health system in WA is appreciated.

How do I access the survey?

This survey is open between 27 February and 27 April 2018.

The survey can be accessed through common browsers such as Internet Explorer, Chrome and Firefox.
