

Recommendations to System Manager (Director General /Minister)





Recommendations for Health Service Boards (Operational Managers)

Clinical Senate makes “Recommendations” for operational managers
(Boards & Chief Executives).



Clinical Senate Chair and Executive Sponsor/s meet with the Director General to ensure the system manager sees no barrier to the recommendations going to Health Service Boards (HSB) and Chief Executives.



Clinical Senate Chair and Executive Sponsor/s write to the HSB Chair asking the HSB to Endorse/Endorse in Principle/Not Endorse recommendations.



HSB’s Endorse/Endorse in Principle/Not Endorse recommendations according to individual HSB processes.



HSB Chairs write to Clinical Senate Chair advising outcomes of recommendations as Endorsed/Endorsed in Principle/Not Endorsed



Clinical Senate Chair feeds back at the next Clinical Senate meeting for each HSB.



Clinical Senate Chair asks Chief Executive’s to report on implementation of Endorsed/Endorsed in Principle recommendations, one year from point of endorsement.
