

# Western Australian Coding Rule

## 0414/09 Delirium on a background of dementia

WA Coding Rule 0613/04 *Delirium on a background of dementia* is superseded by ACCD Coding Rule *Confusion or delirium with dementia* (Ref No: Q2649) effective 1 April 2014; (log in to view on the <u>ACCD CLIP portal</u>).

Note: Delirium is not a behavioural or psychological symptom of dementia in F00-F03.

This advice has a minor modification to correspond with an update in ICD-10-AM/ACHI/ACS Twelfth Edition.

#### **DECISION**

WA Coding Rule 0613/04 Delirium on a background of dementia is retired.

## 0613/04 Delirium on a background of dementia

### Q.

Should documentation of 'delirium on a background of dementia' be coded as delirium superimposed on dementia?

### A.

We have received clinical advice from the Chief Psychiatrist that the documentation of delirium on a background of dementia can be interpreted as delirium superimposed on dementia.

### **DECISION**

Documentation of delirium on a background of dementia can be interpreted as delirium superimposed on dementia and should be coded to F05.1 *Delirium superimposed on dementia*.
