0725/09 Anaemia in miscarriage or termination episode

WA Coding Rule 1010/02 *Anaemia in episode of miscarriage or termination* is retired.

ACS 1521 *Conditions and injuries in pregnancy* was revised in Tenth Edition to clarify the circumstances in which a non-obstetric condition may be classified as a pregnancy complication.

Q.

What code should be assigned for anaemia when occurring with termination or miscarriage?

Is it an O99 code, if so which one? Or do we just use a 'D' code?

A.

If there is a haemorrhage, code as an abortion complicated by haemorrhage. If haemorrhage following a previous spontaneous or induced abortion, see ACS 1544 *Complications following abortion and ectopic and molar pregnancy* for coding guidelines. Anaemia can be coded as an additional diagnosis in these scenarios if it meets ACS 0002 *Additional diagnoses* by assigning the appropriate 'D' code.

DECISION

Assign the appropriate 'D' code for anaemia when occurring with an abortion or termination before 20 weeks gestation.
