0725/57 Myringoplasty with grafting

Q.

Is grafting, such as temporalis fascia graft, inherent in myringoplasty?

A.

Yes, grafting such as a temporalis fascia graft, is an inherent component of myringoplasty.
See ACS 0016 *General intervention guidelines*.

DECISION

Grafting, such as a temporalis fascia graft, is an inherent component of myringoplasty..

This WA Coding Rule 0725/57 *Myringoplasty with grafting* supersedes WA Coding Rule 0210/09 *Transcanal myringoplasty with temporalis fascia graft*.

This Rule has been modified to improve clarity.

0210/09 **Transcanal myringoplasty with temporalis fascia graft**

Q.

ACHI Index pathway: Graft, fascia, temporalis has a cross reference to “see Mastoidectomy”. By following this pathway the coder arrives at 41551-00 [325] *Mastoidectomy by intact wall technique with myringoplasty*. This code is incorrect as mastoidectomy was not performed. Which code should be assigned as 41527-00 [313] *Myringoplasty transcanal approach* does not capture the temporalis fascia graft?

A.

41527-00 [313] *Myringoplasty, transcanal approach* is the correct code to assign. The graft is inherent in this code.

DECISION

Transcanal myringoplasty with temporalis fascia graft should be coded 41527-00 [313] *Myringoplasty, transcanal approach*.
