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Overview

Introduction

This report pertains to data records of Home and Community Care (HACC) clients (care recipients and/or carers), who received or were receiving one or more HACC services between 1 July 2014 and 30 June 2015. This report includes any revised data submitted for all four quarters of the financial year 2014/15.

HACC Program

The WA HACC Program is a provider of basic community care services to frail older people and younger people with disabilities and their carers. The HACC Program aims to maintain or improve the independence of people in these groups and to avoid or delay their premature admission to long term residential care through the provision of basic maintenance and support services.

HACC Minimum Dataset (V2)

The data elements included in the HACC Minimum Data Set (MDS) and defined in the HACC National MDS User Guide Data Dictionary 2.0 are considered to be the minimum information requirements for reporting within the HACC program.

They relate to:

- The characteristics of care recipients (e.g. sex, date of birth, Indigenous status, functional status items)
- The circumstances of care recipients (e.g. where they live, whether they have a carer)
- The characteristics of carers (e.g. date of birth, sex, Indigenous status)
- Information about the service episode (e.g. source of referral, date of entry, date of last update)
- The assistance received by care recipients and carers from the HACC program (e.g. amounts and types of assistance received).



HACC Planning Regions and Subregions are classified according to the Statistical Local Areas (SLAs), based on the Australian Standard Geographical Classification by the Australian Bureau of Statistics. For the purposes of this report, client data is organised into SLAs and Subregions according to care recipient residential postcode as recorded in the HACC MDS. The region classified as 'Others' includes postcodes which are missing, do not fall within any of the HACC planning regions, or relate to P.O. box addresses.



Data Preparation

The HACC MDS is reported to the National Data Repository on a quarterly basis by HACC service providers. All clients receiving HACC services or who ceased receiving services in the quarter will have at least one MDS record. A client may have several MDS records in the period as they may be receiving HACC services from several service providers.

There were 305,594 HACC MDS records in the 2014/15 HACC revised annual data set. Of those, 1,229 records did not have any assistance recorded and were excluded leaving 304,365 records.

A total of 304,365 records were aggregated to care recipient level on the basis of the variable *SLK* resulting in **74,773** records used for the annual report.

It was observed before aggregation that many records of care recipients with multiple MDS entries had differing values for the same variable when two or more agencies were involved. It was decided, for the **purpose of comparisons with the 2013/14 HACC Annual Report**, to apply the **same aggregation rules as in the 2013/14 analysis** to determine the value of each variable used in the analysis:

- 1) The data were first **sorted by ascending SLK and Agency ID**.
- 2) Variables which by definition should have the same value if multiple records are present (i.e. *Country of Birth*, *Main Language spoken*, *Indigenous status*, *DVA*, *Pension status*)

The most frequent value was used; if the most frequent value was “missing” or “not stated” the 2nd most frequent value (if any) was used; if the most frequent value was “missing” or “not stated” as well as another value then the other value was used.
- 3) Variables which could have different values in multiple records (e.g. *Postcode*, *Living arrangements*, *Accommodation setting* could be different if a care recipient moved; Carer details could be different if a carer stopped caring for a person during the year or if another carer took over; *Referral source*, *Reason for cessation* could be different in separate records)

The most frequent value was used; if the most frequent value was “missing” or “not stated” the 2nd most frequent value (if any) was used; if the most frequent value was “missing” or “not stated” as well as another value then the other value was used.
- 4) Carer exists

If this variable had a value of ‘Yes’ in one MDS record of a care recipient with multiple records in the year, then it was assumed that that care recipient had a carer regardless of other records indicating the opposite.

5) Functional status variables

The most frequent value was used; if the most frequent value was “missing” or “not stated” the 2nd most frequent value (if any) was used; if the most frequent value was “missing” or “not stated” as well as another value then the other value was used.

6) Types of assistance variables

The values of each variable for various types of assistance were summed up to generate a variable composed of the total amount of each type of service received.

Clients were allocated to HACC Planning regions and subregions on the basis of their residential postcode which along with suburb/town is reported in the MDS (in the variable *Locality*).

In determining **Carers** and **Carers receiving HACC services** the following variables were used:

Carer:	<i>Carer Exists = Yes</i>
Carer receiving HACC service:	a value > 0 in variable CS/A_C (Counselling-Carer) and/or a value > 0 in variable RC (Respite Care)

Comment:

The HACC Minimum Data Set (MDS) is reported by HACC service providers, and records services provided to both care recipients and their carers. Care recipients may or may not have a carer and only a proportion of carers receive carer specific HACC services, namely - Respite Care and/or Counselling, Support, Information and Advocacy, to support them in their caring role.

The number of care recipients receiving HACC support increased by **4.3%** in the 2014/15 reporting period (**74,773** vs. 71,666 in 2013/14). The proportion of HACC care recipients who reported having a carer this year was lower than last year's report (**25.7%** vs. 27.6% in 2013/14). In actual numbers, it was a decrease of **3.0%** (**19,223** carers down from 19,811 last year). The proportion of carers receiving carer specific HACC services also decreased by **1.2%** (**16.4%** down from 17.6% in last year's report). In actual numbers there were **325** fewer carers receiving HACC services in this year's reporting period (**3,154** carers vs. 3,479 carers in 2013/14).

Comment:

The number of new clients refers to clients who were not receiving any HACC services in the single previous reporting quarter. This may be within the current financial year or for clients reported in the July to September quarter, in the last quarter of the previous financial year. The 2014/15 reporting period recorded an increase (+7.9%) in the number of new clients as compared with 2013/14 (**28,721** vs. 26,621 in 2013/14).



Comment:

During the 2014/15 reporting period, the highest proportion of HACC care recipients were from the 75-89 age group (52.0%), followed by those in the 65-74 age group (18.9%). These proportions were similar to last year's HACC report where the highest proportion of HACC care recipients was from the 75-89 age group (52.0%), followed by 18.6% in the 65-74 group. The proportion of HACC care recipients younger than 50 years was slightly lower compared to last year's report (8.6% vs. 9.0% in 2013/14). Conversely, the proportion of HACC care recipients aged 90 years and above was slightly higher compared to last year (9.0% vs. 8.9% in 2013/14).

Comment:

As shown in Figure 1, the Pilbara and the Kimberley regions have higher proportions of younger care recipients (ages 0-49). This was consistent with data reported in 2013/14.

As with last year's report, the proportion of care recipients with a missing date of birth was very low at **0.01%**.



Figure 2 shows the Pilbara, Goldfields, Kimberley and Midwest regions have the highest proportions of younger HACC care recipients – these include care recipients under 65 years of age and Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander care recipients who are under 50 years of age. This data was similar to last year's report where the proportion of younger HACC care recipients recorded for the Pilbara, Goldfields, Kimberley and Midwest regions were 25.6%, 23.2%, 22.3% and 23.2%, respectively.

Comment:

Consistent with previous years, the number of female HACC care recipients outnumbered male HACC care recipients across all regions in Western Australia. Comment:

In 2014/15, more than half (**59.1%**) of all HACC care recipients were born in Australia. The proportion was similar in 2013/14 with 59.4% of HACC care recipients born in Australia. The highest proportion of HACC care recipients born in a country other than Australia were from Europe (**27.2%**), followed by Asia (**5.3%**). These figures were 27.6% and 5.2% respectively in 2013/14. Country of birth was not recorded for **4.0%** of HACC care recipients in this year's data (up from 3.4% in 2013/14).

Comment:

In 2014/15, the majority of HACC care recipients recorded English as their main language spoken at home, accounting for **88.6%** of all HACC care recipients. This was similar to last year's report where 88.8% of HACC care recipients recorded English as their main language spoken.

HACC care recipients, who recorded a language other than English as their main spoken language made up **7.5%** of the total number of HACC care recipients in 2014/15. The highest proportion of non-English speaking care recipients reported European languages as being their main language spoken at home (**4.7%** of all HACC care recipients); these included Southern European languages (mainly Italian, Greek and French), Eastern European languages (mainly Polish, Macedonian and Croatian) and Northern European languages (mainly German and Dutch). This was similar to last year's figures where 5.1% of HACC care recipients recorded a European language as the main language spoken at home.

Similar with 2013/14, the Kimberley, Goldfields and Pilbara regions recorded the highest number of HACC care recipients whose main spoken language was an Australian Aboriginal language: **303**, **164** and **154** care recipients respectively out of a total **670** care recipients who recorded an Australian Aboriginal language as their main language spoken at home. These were decreases of 16.3% and 22.6% in the Kimberley and Pilbara regions respectively, and an increase of 17.1% in the Goldfields region.

Main language spoken at home was not recorded for **3.9%** of all HACC care recipients, an increase from last year's 3.2%. In actual numbers, it was **2,901** care recipients vs. 2,313 care recipients in 2013/14 who did not record a main language spoken at home.



Comment:

In the 2014/15 reporting period, **3.3%** of all WA HACC care recipients were Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander, a **0.2%** decrease from 3.5% in 2013/14. The majority of Aboriginal care recipients (**77.3%**) were aged 50 years and over. This figure was 76.2% in last year's report.

The proportion of care recipients where Indigenous status was recorded as 'not stated' was **4.4%**, increasing from last year's 3.8%.

Comment:

The highest number of Aboriginal care recipients amongst the rural and remote areas lived in the Kimberley, Goldfields and Midwest regions. When compared with last year's report, this was a decrease of **15.6%** (513 vs. 608 in 2013/14) in the Kimberley region, and increases of **5.0%** (316 vs. 301 in 2013/14) and **13.2%** (257 vs. 227 in 2013/14) in the Goldfields and Midwest region, in the number of Aboriginal care recipients.

Within the metropolitan area, the majority of Aboriginal care recipients were from the South East Metropolitan and East Metropolitan regions, which was consistent with data from 2013/14. The proportion of Aboriginal HACC care recipients increased by **0.5%** in the East Metropolitan region (**193** vs. 192 in 2013/14) and by **2.1%** in the South East Metropolitan region (**389** vs. 381 in 2013/14).

Comment:

Similar to the 2013/14 report, the majority of HACC care recipients live in privately owned homes (**63.8%** vs. 64.6% in 2013/14) or in rental accommodation (**18.6%** vs. 19.3% in 2013/14). A further **7.3%** reside in an independent living unit within a retirement village (7.0% in 2013/14) and **3.9%** in 'other' accommodation which includes 'boarding house/private hotel', 'short-term crisis, emergency or transitional accommodation facility', 'supported accommodation or supported living facility', 'institutional setting', 'public place/temporary shelter', 'private residence rented from an Aboriginal Community' and 'other' (4.1% in 2013/14).

The proportion of care recipients who did not have an accommodation setting recorded (i.e. 'Not stated') was **6.5%**, an increase from last year's 5.0%.



Figure 4: Pension or Benefit Status




Comment:

Care recipients who received an aged pension made up **63.0%** of all HACC care recipients, a **0.3%** decrease from 63.3% in 2013/14.

Those people receiving a disability pension comprised **14.9%** (15.3% in 2013/14) of HACC care recipients with a further **4.3%** (4.9% in 2013/14) receiving a veteran's pension. Less than 10% of care recipients received no government pension or benefit (**9.0%** vs. 8.7% last year).

The proportion of HACC care recipients who did have their pension or benefit status recorded (i.e. 'Not stated') increased to **5.5%** from 4.5% in last year's report.

Comment:

People were referred to the WA HACC Program from a range of sources; the majority of which includes community-based services (34.3%), self-referral (17.1%), family, significant other or friends (9.8%), hospitals (11.9%), general or medical practitioner (6.4%), as well as others shown in Figure 5 above.

These proportions were similar to the 2013/14 HACC MDS annual report, with a **5.2%** increase in the proportion of referrals from community based services (29.1% in 2013/14) and a **2.4%** decrease in the proportion of self-referrals (19.5% in 2013/14).

Comment:

The proportion of HACC care recipients who had a carer recorded in 2014/15 was **25.7%**, a decrease from 27.6% in last year's report. HACC care recipients who recorded not having a carer comprised **70.7%** (up from 69.3% in 2013/14).



Comment:

Consistent with data from the 2013/14 report, the majority of HACC carers belong to the age groups 75-89 years (**30.7%**) and 50-64 years (**28.4%**).

The percentage of carers older than 90 years of age remained the same as last year's report (**2.9%**) while the proportion of carers in the 0-20 age group showed an increase of **0.2%** (1.5% up from 1.3% in 2013/14). Carers with age 'Not stated' also increased by **0.2%** compared to last year's report (**0.8%** up from 0.6% in 2013/14).

Comment:

The proportion of carers receiving HACC assistance was the highest amongst the 0-20 age group (**20.8%**), followed by the 21-49 age group with **19.5%**. This was followed by the 50-64 age group and the 65-74 age group both with **16.8%** receiving HACC assistance. When compared to the 2013/14 HACC MDS annual report, the proportion of carers receiving HACC assistance was the highest amongst the 21-49 age group (**20.7%**), followed by the 50-64 age group with **19.2%** and the 0-20 age group with **18.0%** receiving HACC assistance.



Comment:

In this year's reporting period, **49,109** care recipients had assessment volumes recorded across WA, a **10.5%** increase from 2013/14.

Conversely, there was a decrease in the number of care recipients receiving client care coordination; **6,882** compared to 9,757 in 2013/14 (**-29.5%**).

The most frequently received HACC support service in the 2014/15 reporting period was Domestic assistance (**33,070** care recipients, **+3.4%** from 2013/14) followed by Transport (**17,840** care recipients, **-2.4%**), Home maintenance (**17,660** care recipients, **+0.2%**), Social support (**13,773** care recipients, **-2.7%**), Counselling, support, information and advocacy for care recipients (**12,047** care recipients, **-2.3%**), Centre-based day care (**9,994** care recipients, **-8.2%**), Nursing care (**9,951** care recipients, **+1.8%**), Personal Care (**7,149** care recipients, **+6.6%**).

The remaining service types (in descending order) included Meals (**4,856** care recipients, **-15.6%**), Allied health (**4,272** care recipients, **+15.0%**), Provision of goods and equipment (**3,821** care recipients, **-2.0%**) Counselling, support, information and advocacy for carers (**2,040** carers, **-6.8%**) and Respite care (**1,478** carers, **-6.3%**).

The service types recording the lowest number of care recipients were similar to the 2013/14 report: Linen service recorded no service volumes while other food services and Home modification had **608 (-15.8%)** and **977 (+31.0%)** care recipients respectively.



Comment:

The highest volume by hours of support provided to care recipients in this year was again for Centre-based day care. HACC care recipients who received Centre-based day care for one or more quarters received an average of **164.3** hours over the year, a **1.7%** increase from 161.6 hours last year. The next highest average volumes per client were **79.7** hours for Respite care (**+0.5%** from 79.3 hours in 2013/14), followed by **58.9** hours for Social support (**+20.0%** from 49.1 hours in 2013/14), **51.8** hours for Personal care (**+4.2%** from 49.7 hours in 2013/14), and **36.4** hours for Other food services (**+58.3%** from 23.0 hours in 2013/14). The order of ranking by 'highest volumes by hours of service' this year is mostly similar to the 2013/14 HACC MDS Annual Report. In actual average volume by hours there were increases for most service types except for Client care coordination, Assessment and Counselling services for both Carers and Care Recipients.

For support services measured in quantities, the highest average volumes provided were – **107.6** Meals (**+4.5%** from 103.0 in 2013/14), **49.9** trips for transport (**+1.6%** from 49.1 in 2013/14), and **2.2** items for Goods and equipment (**+57.1%** from 1.4 in 2013/14). The ranking was mostly similar to the 2013/14 HACC MDS Annual Report.

For Home modification, which is recorded in cost, the average cost per care recipient who received this assistance type was **\$2,460.90**. This was almost twice (**+95.5%**) the average cost in 2013/14 (\$1,258.90).

Comment:

The majority of clients (**44.8%**) received only one type of assistance, followed by **24.4%** receiving two types, **14.3%** with three types and **8.2%** with four. This is similar to last year's proportions of 41.6%, 24.8%, 14.9% and 8.9% respectively.

Of the remaining, **8.1%** had between five and nine service types with **43** clients receiving ten or more types of assistance. These figures were 9.8% and 71 respectively in the 2013/14 HACC Annual Report.

Figure 9: Number of Different Service Types Received by Clients





Comment:

In this year's reporting period, a total of **17,638** care recipients ceased receiving services from the HACC program for various reasons; this was a **6.7%** decrease compared to last year's report (or 1,275 care recipients less). The majority (**23.8%**) reported the reason for cessation was improved status where assistance was no longer required. This figure is higher than last year's report (19.0%). A further **14.2%** recorded not requiring assistance from a particular service provider due to improved status (12.9% in 2013/14) but may have continued with a different type of assistance from another service provider.

Other reasons reported by HACC service providers for cessation of assistance included: reasons not specified (**11.5%**), care recipient terminated service (**9.8%**), care recipient died (**9.0%**), client moved to other community based service (**7.9%**), care recipient moved to residential aged care (**7.8%**), care recipient moved out of area (**4.0%**), care recipient moved to other institutional setting (**2.8%**) and service provider was unable to provide assistance (**1.5%**). The remaining **7.6%** of care recipients who ceased receiving services in 2014/15 did not record a reason for cessation of HACC services, an increase from 7.4% in 2013/14.

Comment:

The 2014/15 reporting period recorded increases in the proportion of missing data for most variables presented on Table 21. The variable *Postcode* remained the same at **0.00%** compared to last year's report, while *Country of Birth* increased by **0.6%** (**4.0%** in 2014/15 up from 3.4% in 2013/14).

Missing data for the variable *Sex* increased to **0.05%** compared to last year's report (0.04% in 2013/14). Missing data for care recipient's *Main Language* increased by **0.7%** (**3.9%** vs. 3.2% in 2013/14)

Variables *Indigenous status* and *Carer's Date of Birth* also had higher proportions of missing values when compared to the 2013/14 annual report, increasing by **0.6%** and **0.2%** respectively. *Carer's Sex* was not recorded for **0.7%** of all carers. This figure was 0.6% in last year's report.
