Common side effects

The most common side effect following Zostavax® vaccination is soreness at the injection site.

Seek immediate medical attention if you:

- develop a chickenpox-like rash within 2 to 4 weeks of vaccination
- feel unwell
- develop a fever.

Tell your doctor that you have recently received Zostavax[®].
